## SINGAPORE ART MUSEUM

## CHINESE HERITAGE CENTRE

Discover various national monuments of Singapore through a jigsaw puzzle game with your family members. Families will get to bring home their completed jigsaw sets!

## EURASIAN HERITAGE CENTRE

Experience Eurasian culture – a blend of the East and West – through crafts like crocheting, knitting and tatting, which were used to sew clothes and household items such as coasters, doilies and pouches.

## GAN HERITAGE CENTRE

Understand Asian values and cultures better through fun games and a hands-on Yan style calligraphy workshop.

## MALAY HERITAGE CENTRE

Inspired by goods traded by merchants and philanthropists from the *Nusantara* (Malay Archipelago), create your own *haj* belt or *keronsang*, and strike a pose in *baju kurung* and other traditional accessories!

## MINT MUSEUM OF TOYS

Jam to the Beatles and other tunes from the 60s with an ukelele, or sew your own set of 'five stones' to play with family and friends!

## NATIONAL GALLERY SINGAPORE

Beat the heat by making your own paddle hand fan and personalising it with doodles from the Children's Biennale!

## NUS MUSEUM

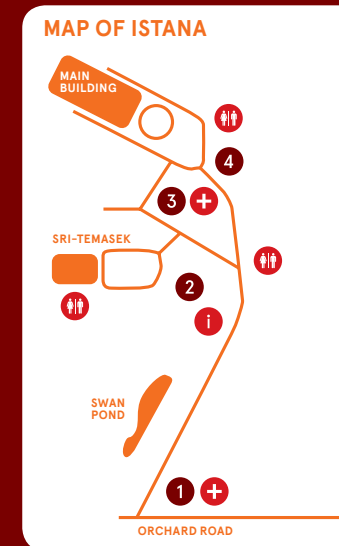
